This Friday marks the day that Jesus was crucified. Scripture describes it as a gruesome, merciless death. Jesus endured this, in no uncertain terms, as the price for our sins. God's wrath, not His love, was satisfied on this day. But it was out of His great love that He provided His own sacrifice to save His people: Jesus! We call this horrendous day of Jesus' death "good" because no love is greater than the One who lays down His life for His friends. Jesus is so good to us. Please read Matthew 27, Mark 15, Luke 23 and John 19 for the Biblical accounts of Jesus' death.

1. Be Present

Sing when the leader sings, pray when the pastor prays, say "amen" or "hallelujah" out loud when you hear something that resonates with you.
