SERMON: "6 RESURRECTION TRUTHS: GOD'S UNSTOPPABLE MISSION" Pastor Jason Scheler

*He presented himself **alive** to them after his suffering by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the **kingdom of God**. (Acts 1:3)*

1. GOD'S MISSION IS _____.

A. GOD'S MISSION CHANGES _____.

Now **many signs and wonders were regularly done** among the people by the hands of the apostles. And they were all together in Solomon's Portico. ¹³None of the rest dared join them, but the people held them in high esteem. ¹⁴And more than ever believers were added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women, ¹⁵so that they even carried out the sick into the streets and laid them on cots and mats, that as Peter came by at least his shadow might fall on some of them. ¹⁶The people also gathered from the towns around Jerusalem, bringing the sick and those afflicted with unclean spirits, and **they were all healed**. (Acts 5:12 – 16)

B. GOD'S MISSION SPEAKS _____ OF LIFE.

But during the night an angel of the Lord opened the prison doors and brought them out, and said, ²⁰"Go and **stand in the temple and speak to the people all the words of this Life**." (Acts 5:19 – 20)

2. GOD'S MISSION WILL FACE _____.

A. THE OPPOSITION WILL TELL YOU TO _____.

And when they had brought them, they set them before the council. And the high priest questioned them, ²⁸saying, "**We strictly charged you not to teach in this name, yet here you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching, and you intend to bring this man's blood upon us**." (Acts 5:27 – 28)

B. THE OPPOSITION WILL BE _____ OF YOU.

But the high priest rose up, and all who were with him (that is, the party of the Sadducees), and **filled with jealousy** ¹⁸they arrested the apostles and put them in the public prison. (Acts 5:17 – 18)

C. THE OPPOSITION WILL BE _____ WITH YOU.

When they heard this, they were **enraged and wanted to kill them**. (Acts 5:33)

D. THE OPPOSITION WILL TRY TO _____ YOU TO STOP.

So they took his (Gamaliel's) advice, ⁴⁰and when they had called in the apostles, they **beat them and charged them not to speak in the name of Jesus**, and let them go. (Acts 5:39 – 40)

3. GOD'S MISSION WILL NEVER _____.

A. HUMAN ENDEAVORS WILL END IN _____.

But a Pharisee in the council named Gamaliel, a teacher of the law held in honor by all the people, stood up and gave orders to put the men outside for a little while. ³⁵And he said to them, "Men of Israel, take care what you are about to do with these men...." ³⁸So in the present case I tell you, keep away from these men and let them alone, **for if this plan or this undertaking is of man, it will fail**; (Acts 5:34 – 35, 38)

EXAMPLE 1: Theudas and the 400

For before these days Theudas rose up, claiming to be somebody, and a number of men, about four hundred, joined him. He was killed, and all who followed him were dispersed and came to nothing. (Acts 5:36)

EXAMPLE 2: Judas the Galilean

After him Judas the Galilean rose up in the days of the census and drew away some of the people after him. He too perished, and all who followed him were scattered. (Acts 5:37)

B. GOD'S MISSION CAN'T BE _____.

but if it is of God, you will not be able to overthrow them. **You might even be found opposing God!** (Acts 5:39)

4. GOD'S MISSION IS ALL ABOUT _____.

The God of our fathers raised Jesus, whom you killed by hanging him on a tree. ³¹God exalted him at his right hand as Leader and Savior, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins. ³²And we

are **witnesses to these things**, and so is the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey him. (Acts 5:30 – 32)

5. GOD'S MISSION WILL STAND _____ IN THE FACE OF OPPOSITION BY...

A. KNOWING _____ WE SERVE.

But Peter and the apostles answered, "We must obey God rather than men." (Acts 5:29)

B. _____ TO GOD'S CALL.

*And when they heard this, they entered the temple at daybreak and began to teach.... ²⁵And someone came and told them, "Look! The men whom you put in prison are **standing in the temple and teaching the people.**" (Acts 5:21, 25)*

C. _____ DOING WHAT GOD CALLED YOU TO DO WITH JOY IN YOUR HEART!

Then they left the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer dishonor for the name. (Acts 5:41)
