SERMON: "6 RESURRECTION TRUTHS: GOD'S CHURCH IS A TEAM"

Now in these days when the disciples were increasing in number, a complaint by the Hellenists arose against the Hebrews because their widows were being neglected in the daily distribution. ²And the twelve summoned the full number of the disciples and said, "It is not right that we should give up preaching the word of God to serve tables. ³Therefore, brothers, pick out from among you seven men of good repute, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we will appoint to this duty. ⁴But we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word." ⁵And what they said pleased the whole gathering, and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolaus, a proselyte of Antioch. ⁶These they set before the apostles, and they prayed and laid their hands on them. I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, ²with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, ³eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. ⁴There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call— ⁵one Lord, one faith, one baptism, ⁶one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all. ⁷But grace was given to each one of us according to the measure of Christ's gift.

Going Deeper in the Home

1. Revisit the 3 dysfunctions of God's team above. Do any of these resonate with you? Read a passage of Scripture that proclaims God's love (Psalm 32, Psalm 51, or Romans 8:1 for example) and pray for God to begin a new approach to being on His team. This is how we move from obligation to living out our Baptism.
2. Reread John 20:19-23 with your household or close friends. Prayerfully imagine what might change if you believed that you receive the peace, the sending, and the joy to forgive that Jesus gives. Ask God to strengthen your faith around these gifts and for the power to live them out.
