## 1. GOD SETS HIS PEOPLE APART.

“and you shall be to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.” (Exodus 19:6a)

## 3. GOD SENT THE HIGH PRIEST TO SAVE HIS PEOPLE.

“For it was indeed fitting that we should have such a high priest, holy, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, and exalted above the heavens. <sup>27</sup> He has no need, like those high priests, to offer sacrifices daily, first for his own sins and then for those of the people, since he did this once for all when he offered up himself.” (Hebrews 7:26-27)
