SERMON: "EZRA & NEHEMIAH: TRUE REPENTANCE"

1. EZRA AND OTHERS _____ GOD FOR MERCY.

While Ezra was praying and confessing, weeping and throwing himself down before the house of God, a large crowd of Israelites—men, women and children—gathered around him. They too wept bitterly. (Ezra 10:1 NIV)

2. THE LEADERS _____ AND IDENTIFIED THEIR SIN ACCORDING TO GOD'S WORD.

Then Shekariah said to Ezra, "We have been unfaithful to our God by marrying foreign women from the peoples around us." (Ezra 10:2a NIV)

3. THEY COMMITTED TO _____ TOGETHER.

Now let us make a covenant before our God to send away all these women and their children, in accordance with the counsel of my lord and of those who fear the commands of our God. Let it be done according to the Law. ⁴Rise up; this matter is in your hands. We will support you, so take courage and do it." ⁵So Ezra rose up and put the leading priests and Levites and all Israel under oath to do what had been suggested. And they took the oath. (Ezra 10:3-5 NIV)

4. THIS WAS A _____ PROCESS WITH CONSEQUENCES.

A proclamation was then issued throughout Judah and Jerusalem for all the exiles to assemble in Jerusalem. ⁸Anyone who failed to appear within three days would forfeit all his property, in accordance with the decision of the officials and elders, and would himself be expelled from the assembly of the exiles. ⁹Within the three days, all the men of Judah and Benjamin had gathered in Jerusalem. And on the twentieth day of the ninth month, all the people were sitting in the square before the house of God, greatly distressed by the occasion and because of the rain. ¹⁰Then Ezra the priest stood up and said to them, "You have been unfaithful; you have married foreign women, adding to Israel's guilt. ¹¹Now honor the LORD, the God of your ancestors, and do his will. Separate yourselves from the peoples around you and from your foreign wives." (Ezra 10:7-11 NIV)

5. THEY OWNED THEIR SIN AND THE _____.

The whole assembly responded with a loud voice: "You are right! We must do as you say." ¹⁶So the exiles did as was proposed. (Ezra 10:12,16 NIV)

2. GO AS _____ BEFORE YOUR HEAVENLY FATHER.

I will set out and go back to my father and say to him: Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. ¹⁹I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me like one of your hired servants. (Luke 15:18-19 NIV)

3. IDENTIFY YOUR SINS ACCORDING TO GOD'S WORD. (Exodus 20:17 NIV)

5. BE _____ TO BEAR THE CONSEQUENCES.

But Zacchaeus stood up and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord! Here and now I give half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount." (Luke 19:8 NIV)

6. _____ FOR FORGIVENESS.

Then I acknowledged my sin to you and did not cover up my iniquity. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord." And you forgave the guilt of my sin. (Psalm 32:5 NIV)

7. _____ IN CHRIST'S FORGIVENESS.

For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, ¹⁴in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins. (Colossians 1:13-14 NIV)
