SERMON

“CONVERSATIONS WITH JESUS: BE DIFFERENT”

1. **JESUS IS A DIFFERENT KIND OF LEADER.**

They were now on the way up to Jerusalem, and Jesus was walking ahead of them. The disciples were filled with awe, and the people following behind were overwhelmed with fear. Taking the twelve disciples aside, Jesus once more began to describe everything that was about to happen to him. ³³“Listen,” he said, “we’re going up to Jerusalem, where the Son of Man will be betrayed to the leading priests and the teachers of religious law. They will sentence him to die and hand him over to the Romans. ³⁴They will mock him, spit on him, flog him with a whip, and kill him, but after three days he will rise again.”
(Mark 10:32-34 NLT)

2. **THE DISCIPLES ARE NOT DIFFERENT.**

Then James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came over and spoke to him. “Teacher,” they said, “we want you to do us a favor.” ³⁶“What is your request?” he asked. ³⁷They replied, “When you sit on your glorious throne, we want to sit in places of honor next to you, one on your right and the other on your left.” ³⁸But Jesus said to them, “You don’t know what you are asking! Are you able to drink from the bitter cup of suffering I am about to drink? Are you able to be baptized with the baptism of suffering I must be baptized with?” ³⁹“Oh yes,” they replied, “we are able!” Then Jesus told them, “You will indeed drink from my bitter cup and be baptized with my baptism of suffering. ⁴⁰But I have no right to say who will sit on my right or my left. God has prepared those places for the ones he has chosen.” ⁴¹When the ten other disciples heard what James and John had asked, they were indignant.
(Mark 10:35-41 NLT)

3. **JESUS COMMANDS THEM TO BE DIFFERENT.**

So Jesus called them together and said, “You know that the rulers in this world lord it over their people, and officials flaunt their authority over those under them. (Mark 10:42 NLT)

MEMORY VERSE

But among you it will be different. (Mark 10:43a NLT)

Whoever wants to be a leader among you must be your servant, ⁴⁴and whoever wants to be first among you must be the slave of everyone else. ⁴⁵For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many.”
(Mark 10:43b-45 NLT)

4. **THEY BECAME DIFFERENT BY THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.**

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. (Acts 1:4-5 NLT)
