MEMORY VERSE

Do everything without grumbling or arguing, (Philippians 2:14)

¹⁵so that you may become blameless and pure, "children of God without fault in a warped and crooked generation." Then you will shine among them like stars in the sky ¹⁶as you hold firmly to the word of life. And then I will be able to boast on the day of Christ that I did not run or labor in vain. ¹⁷But even if I am being poured out like a drink offering on the sacrifice and service coming from your faith, I am glad and rejoice with all of you. ¹⁸So you too should be glad and rejoice with me. (Philippians 2:15-18 NIV)

BEING CHILDREN OF GOD REQUIRES THAT WE HAVE A LIFE MARKED NOT BY GRUMBLING AND DISPUTING, BUT BY JOY, EVEN IN TRIALS.

1. THE GOSPEL OF CHRIST SHOULD BE THE UTMOST IN OUR THINKING SO IT AFFECTS ALL OUR ATTITUDES AND BEHAVIOR.

They are corrupt and not his children; to their shame they are a warped and crooked generation. (Deuteronomy 32:5 NIV)

So the people grumbled against Moses, saying, "What are we to drink?" (Exodus 15:24 NIV)

In the desert the whole community grumbled against Moses and Aaron. (Exodus 16:2 NIV)

Moses also said, "You will know that it was the LORD when he gives you meat to eat in the evening and all the bread you want in the morning, because he has heard your grumbling against him. Who are we? You are not grumbling against us, but against the LORD." (Exodus 16:8)

2. INSTEAD OF GRUMBLING WE ARE TO SHINE...

A. BLAMELESS: OUTWARD MORAL INTEGRITY

B. INNOCENT: INWARD MORAL INTEGRITY

We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ. (2 Corinthians 10:5 NIV)

C. ABOVE REPROACH: WITHOUT BLEMISH

3. GRUMBLING AND DISPUTING GRIEVES THE HOLY SPIRIT IN US.

And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. (Ephesians 4:30 NIV)

4. OUR TESTIMONY OF CHRIST SHINES FORTH WHEN WE ARE FILLED WITH JOY EVEN IN THE MIDST OF TRIALS.

remember that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the

world. ¹³But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ. (Ref. Ephesians 2:1-11 NIV/ Ephesians 2:12-13 NIV)

5. WHEN WE COMPLAIN WE NEED TO REPENT, RETURN TO THE WORD, AND REDISCOVER THE JOY IN GOD AND HIS WORK.

A. REPENT

The people came to Moses and said, "We sinned when we spoke against the LORD and against you. Pray that the LORD will take the snakes away from us." So Moses prayed for the people. ⁸The LORD said to Moses, "Make a snake and put it up on a pole; anyone who is bitten can look at it and live." Then when anyone was bitten by a snake and looked at the bronze snake, they lived. (Numbers 21:7-8a, c NIV)

B. BE PREPARED WITH THE WORD OF GOD AND HIS SPIRIT. (Philippians 2:16)

Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will. (Romans 12:2a NIV)

C. HAVE JOY IN OBEDIENCE. (Philippians 2:17-18)

GOING DEEPER IN THE HOME

1. The Psalmists sometimes complained to the Lord. Is that okay?
2. If you are in a bad situation is it wrong to complain to those in charge or to a friend?
3. Why is affirming the sovereignty of God in all things so important in learning to live with joy rather than with grumbling?
