SERMON: "THE HIDDEN GIFT: DO NOT COMMIT ADULTERY"
Pastor Jason Scheler

1. WHAT DOES THIS COMMANDMENT SAY ABOUT GOD?

A. GOD IS A COVENANT GOD WHO IS LOVING AND FOREVER FAITHFUL.

Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. ²³For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior. ²⁴Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit in everything to their husbands. (Ephesians 5:22-24 ESV)

"Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." ³²This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church. (Ephesians 5:31-32 ESV)

B. MARRIAGE IS A MODEL OF HIS RELATIONSHIP WITH HIS PEOPLE.

Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, ²⁶that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, ²⁷so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish. (Ephesians 5:25-27 ESV)

2. WHAT DOES IT SAY ABOUT US?

A. WE ARE PRONE TO BE NARCISSISTIC.

- "I AM NOT GETTING MY NEEDS MET HERE, SO I AM GOING THERE TO MEET MY NEEDS."

But understand this, that in the last days there will come times of difficulty. ²For people will be lovers of self, ..proud... unholy, ...unappeasable, ...swollen with conceit, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, ⁵having the appearance of godliness, but denying its power. (2 Timothy 3:1-5 ESV)

MEMORY VERSE

But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. (Galatians 5:16 ESV)

B. YOU CAN'T BREAK THIS COMMANDMENT UNLESS YOU BREAK THE FIRST COMMANDMENT FIRST.

For among them are those who creep into households and capture weak women, burdened with sins and led astray by various passions (2 Timothy 3:6 ESV)

3. HOW DOES IT POINT US TO JESUS?

A. WE NEED TO BE SAVED FROM OUR OWN SINFUL DESIRES.

But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8 ESV)

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9 ESV)

B. WE NEED TO TURN TO CHRIST AS OUR SOURCE OF SATISFACTION, IDENTITY, MEANING, AND FULFILLMENT, NOT SEX.

Flee from sexual immorality. Every other sin a person commits is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against his own body. ¹⁹Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, ²⁰for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

(1 Corinthians 6:18-20 ESV)

4. HOW DOES THIS LEAD US TO LIFE?

A. BY GOD'S GRACE I AM FREE TO LIVE SELFLESSLY AND TRULY LOVE.

i. PURSUE JESUS.

For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you abstain from sexual immorality; ⁴that each one of you know how to control his own body in holiness and honor, ⁵not in the passion of lust like the Gentiles who do not know God; (1 Thessalonians 4:3-5 ESV)

ii. PURSUE YOUR SPOUSE.

Drink water from your own cistern, flowing water from your own well. ¹⁶Should your springs be scattered abroad, streams of water in the streets? ¹⁷Let them be for yourself alone, and not for strangers with you. Let your fountain be blessed, and rejoice in the wife of your youth, a lovely deer, a graceful doe. ¹⁸Let her breasts fill you at all times with delight; be intoxicated always in her love. (Proverbs 5:15-18 ESV)

- **GOD'S ANSWER FOR SEX IS SEX IN A COVENANT RELATIONSHIP.**

iii. PURSUE HOLINESS IN YOUR THOUGHTS.

- **SET BOUNDARIES**

Rather, clothe yourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ, and do not think about how to gratify the desires of the flesh. (Romans 13:14 NIV)

- **INTENTIONALLY PURSUE HOLINESS WITH OTHERS.**

Run from anything that stimulates youthful lusts. Instead, pursue righteous living, faithfulness, love, and peace. Enjoy the companionship of those who call on the Lord with pure hearts. (2 Timothy 2:22 NLT)

GOING DEEPER IN THE HOME

1. Where am I most prone to selfish thinking and behavior, particularly as it relates to sexuality?
2. Where have I sought joy and happiness outside of Christ?
3. Do I pursue a life of holiness or do I try to get as close as I can to sin without "crossing the line?" How might the grace of God lead me back to righteous living by His power?
4. Do I invest in my marriage or dating relationships with purpose and intentionality? Do I guard myself against steps toward adultery?

Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.
