1. WHAT DOES THIS COMMANDMENT SAY ABOUT GOD?

A. GOD LOVES THE TRUTH.

B. GOD LOVES HIS PEOPLE.

C. TRUTH UNITES HIS PEOPLE.

D. WHAT IS A LIE?

i. Saying anything that is untrue and not saying all that is true.

ii. The aim of any lie is deception.

E. GOD HATES LYING.

There are six things the LORD hates—no, seven things he detests:... a lying tongue, ...,¹⁹a false witness who pours out lies, (Proverbs 6:16-19 ESV)

F. GOD’S WORD IS TRUTH.

This truth gives them confidence that they have eternal life, which God—who does not lie—promised them before the world began. (Titus 1:2 NLT)

Not one word has failed of all his good promise, which he spoke by Moses his servant. (1 Kings 8:56b NLT)

Not one of all the LORD’s good promises to Israel failed; everyone was fulfilled. (Joshua 21:45 NIV)

G. LYING IS THE CHARACTER OF SATAN.

You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father’s desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies. (John 8:44 ESV)

H. GOD COMMANDS THAT WE BE TRUTHFUL BECAUSE HE HAS ONLY BEEN TRUTHFUL TO US.

2. WHAT DOES THIS COMMANDMENT REVEAL ABOUT US?

A. PEOPLE ARE PRONE TO DISHONESTY.

i. **OUTRIGHT DECEPTION TO BRING HARM TO OTHERS OR GAINS FOR OURSELVES**

ii. **SLANDER: FALSEHOOD TO ASSASSINATE SOMEONE’S CHARACTER**

iii. **GOSSIP AND RUMORS**

A dishonest man spreads strife, and a whisperer separates close friends. (Proverbs 16:28 ESV)

iv. **EXAGGERATION**

v. **FLATTERY**

Everyone utters lies to his neighbor; with flattering lips and a double heart they speak. (Psalm 12:2 ESV)

vi. **NOT KEEPING YOUR WORD**

Simply let your ‘Yes’ be ‘Yes,’ and your ‘No,’ ‘No.’ Anything more comes from the evil one. (Matthew 5:37 BSB)

vii. **DECEIVING YOURSELF**

If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. ¹⁰If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us. (1 John 1:8,10 ESV)

B. WE ARE INSECURE IN OURSELVES AND NEEDY FOR FULL ACCEPTANCE.

3. HOW DOES THIS COMMANDMENT POINT US TO JESUS?

Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. (John 14:6 ESV)

MEMORY VERSE

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9 ESV)

4. HOW DOES THIS COMMANDMENT LEAD YOU TO THE PATH OF LIFE?

A. YOU ARE FULLY KNOWN AND ACCEPTED BY GOD THROUGH JESUS; THEREFORE, I CAN BE FEARLESS TO TELL THE TRUTH.

B. I AM FREE TO LOVE OTHERS.

Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins.
(1 Peter 4:8 ESV)

Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, ¹⁶from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love. (Ephesians 4:15-16 ESV)

Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.
⁸Love never ends. (1 Corinthians 13:7-8a ESV)
