Then Jesus said to his disciples, "Those who want to come with me must say no to the things they want, pick up their crosses, and follow me. (Matthew 16:24 GW)
3. ARE YOU READY TO GO MINISTER TO A HOSTILE WORLD? YES / NO
4. HOW DOES THE MODERN CHURCH RESPOND TO A HOSTILE WORLD?
 - A. WE COMPROMISE BECAUSE WE ARE AFRAID.

There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love. (1 John 4:18 ESV)

At that time Herod the tetrarch heard about the fame of Jesus, ²and he said to his servants, "This is John the Baptist. He has been raised from the dead; that is why these miraculous powers are at work in him." ³For Herod had seized John and bound him and put him in prison for the sake of Herodias, his brother Philip's wife, ⁴because John had

been saying to him, "It is not lawful for you to have her." ⁵And though he wanted to put him to death, he feared the people, because they held him to be a prophet.
(Matthew 14:1-5 ESV)

i. **HEROD FEARED THE MIRACULOUS POWER AND LOSING HIS POWER.**

ii. **WHAT IS UNDER HEROD'S FEAR? GUILT**

But when Herod's birthday came, the daughter of Herodias danced before the company and pleased Herod, ⁷so that he promised with an oath to give her whatever she might ask. ⁸Prompted by her mother, she said, "Give me the head of John the Baptist here on a platter." ⁹And the king was sorry, but because of his oaths and his guests he commanded it to be given. ¹⁰He sent and had John beheaded in the prison, ¹¹and his head was brought on a platter and given to the girl, and she brought it to her mother. (Matthew 14:6-11 ESV)

5. **HOW DID JOHN MINISTER IN A HOSTILE WORLD?**

A. **HE SPOKE A NONCOMPROMISING TRUTH THAT CALLED FOR REPENTANCE OF SINS IN THE DESERT.**

...having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, ¹⁹and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might ²⁰that he worked in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places, (Ephesians 1:18-20 ESV)

For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. (Matthew 16:25 ESV)

6. **WHAT DOES JESUS DO IN THE FACE OF OPPOSITION?**

And his disciples came and took the body and buried it, and they went and told Jesus. ¹³Now when Jesus heard this, he withdrew from there in a boat to a desolate place by himself.
(Matthew 14:12-13a ESV)

Large crowds were traveling with Jesus. He turned to them and said, ²⁶"If people come to me and are not ready to abandon their fathers, mothers, wives, children, brothers, and sisters, as well as their own lives, they cannot be my disciples. ²⁷So those who do not carry their crosses and follow me cannot be my disciples. ³³In the same way, none of you can be my disciples unless you give up everything. (Matthew 14: 25-27,33 ESV)
