JESUS ASKS QUESTIONS TO LEAD US INTO DEEPER TRUST IN HIM.

⁴⁰And when he had said this, he showed them his hands and his feet. ⁴¹And while they still disbelieved for joy and were marveling, he said to them, "Have you anything here to eat?" ⁴²They gave him a piece of broiled fish, ⁴³and he took it and ate before them. (Luke 24:40-43)



JESUS IS THE REAL DEAL.

BREAKING BREAD TOGETHER IS IMPORTANT AND SIGNIFICANT BECAUSE...

1. JESUS IS THE BREAD OF LIFE.

Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in me shall never thirst." (John 6:35)

2. WE ARE REMINDED WHAT IS ESSENTIAL.

⁴⁴Then he said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled." (Luke 24:44)

3. IT CREATES TEACHABLE MOMENTS.

⁴⁵Then he <u>opened their minds</u> to understand the Scriptures, ⁴⁶and said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead," (Luke 24:45-46)

One who heard us was a woman named Lydia, from the city of Thyatira, a seller of purple goods, who was a worshiper of God. <u>The Lord opened her heart</u> to pay attention to what was said by Paul. (Acts 16:14)

They said to each other, "Did not our hearts burn within us while he talked to us on the road, while he opened to us the Scriptures?" (Luke 24:32)

4. IT GIVES DIRECTION AND IDENTITY.

⁴⁷and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins <u>should be proclaimed</u> in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. ⁴⁸You are <u>witnesses</u> of these things. (Luke 24:47-48)

5. IT EMPOWERS YOU.

⁴⁹And behold, <u>I am sending the promise of my Father upon you</u>. But <u>stay</u> in the city until you are <u>clothed</u> with power from on high. (Luke 24:49)
