# 1. WHAT DO YOU DO WHEN THERE IS A DELAY TO YOUR EXPECTATIONS?

When the people saw that Moses delayed to come down from the mountain, the people gathered themselves together to Aaron and said to him, "Up, make us gods who shall go before us. As for this Moses, the man who brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we do not know what has become of him." (Exodus 32:1)

# A. WE OFTEN TRY TO FILL THE VOID OURSELVES.

And he received the gold from their hand and fashioned it with a graving tool and made a golden calf. And they said, "These are your gods, O Israel, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt!" (Exodus 32:4)

# B. THERE IS A DANGER IN MIXING IDOLATRY AND THE ONE TRUE GOD.

No servant can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money." (Luke 16:13)

# 2. GOD DEMANDS YOUR FAITH IN HIM ALONE.

"Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might." (Deuteronomy 6:4-5)

# A. GOD BRINGS A JUDGMENT AGAINST SIN.
