SERMON: "IN GOD WE TRUST: DON'T DRINK THE POISON OF EXPECTATIONS" Pastor Jason Scheler

Now when John heard in prison about the deeds of the Christ, he sent word by his disciples ³and said to him, "Are you the one who is to come, or shall we look for another?" ⁴And Jesus answered them, "Go and tell John what you hear and see: ⁵the blind receive their sight and the lame walk, lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear, and the dead are raised up, and the poor have good news preached to them. ⁶And blessed is the one who is not offended by me." (Matthew 11:2-6 NIV)

THE NUMBER ONE REASON PEOPLE LIVE OFFENDED IS <u>UNFULFILLED</u> EXPECTATIONS.

1. THE FIRST GLASS IS <u>UNSPOKEN</u> EXPECTATIONS.

2. THE SECOND GLASS IS <u>UNMET</u> EXPECTATIONS.

Good sense makes one slow to anger, and it is his glory to overlook an offense. (Proverbs 19:11 ESV)

Do not rebuke a mocker, or he will hate you; rebuke a wise man, and he will love you. (Proverbs 9:8 NIV)

3. THE THIRD GLASS IS UNREALISTIC EXPECTATIONS.

Pay attention to yourselves! If your brother sins, rebuke him, and if he repents, forgive him, (Luke 17:3 ESV)

Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others. (Colossians 3:13 NLT)

MEMORY VERSE

Hatred stirs up strife, but love covers all offenses. (Proverbs 10:12 ESV)
