Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; life does not consist in an abundance of possessions." (Luke 12:15 NIV)

GOOD NEWS, BAD NEWS

1. THE GOOD NEWS IS: YOU ARE RICH!

Moreover, when <u>God gives someone wealth and possessions</u>, <u>and the ability to enjoy them</u>, to accept their lot and be happy in their toil—this is a gift of God. (Ecclesiastes 5:19 NIV)

2. THE BAD NEWS IS: YOU'RE RICH!

A. SPIRITUAL DISADVANTAGE.

Jesus looked at him and said, "How hard it is for the rich to enter the kingdom of God! ²⁵Indeed, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God." (Luke 18:24-25 NIV)

B. TO WHOM MUCH IS GIVEN; MUCH IS REQUIRED.

C. WE DON'T NEED MORE MONEY; WE NEED MORE JESUS.
