SERMON: "PALM SUNDAY: PRINCE OF PEACE"

And when he drew near and saw the city, he wept over it, ⁴²saying, "Would that you, even you, had known on this day the things that make for peace! (Luke 19:41-42 ESV)

WHAT IS PEACE?

1. HEALTH, COMPLETENESS, REST, AND WELL-BEING

As he was drawing near—already on the way down the Mount of Olives—the whole multitude of his disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen, ³⁸saying, "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!" (Luke 19:37-38 ESV)

2. SHALOM: A RELATIONSHIP OF LOVE AND LOYALITY WITH GOD.

3. PEACE IS NOT MORALIST THERAPEUTIC DEISM.

Jesus looked at them and said, "With man it is impossible, but not with God. For all things are possible with God." (Mark 10:27 ESV)

JESUS WAS NOT A MILITARY KING. HE WAS THE MESSIAH KING OF PEACE.

Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid. (John 14:27 ESV)

1. JESUS KNEW THEY WOULD FALL IN THE COMING DAYS.

But now they are hidden from your eyes. (Luke 19:42b ESV)

Therefore, since we have been made right in God's sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us. ²Because of our faith, Christ has brought us into this place of undeserved privilege where we now stand, and we confidently and joyfully look forward to sharing God's glory. (Romans 5:1-2 NLT)
