"LOVE LIKE JESUS: FORGIVE SINNERS" Pastor Jason Scheler

For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. ¹⁵But if you <u>do not forgive others their sins</u>, your Father <u>will not forgive your sins</u>. (Matthew 6:14-15 NIV)

Two other men, both criminals, were also led out with [Jesus] to be executed. ³³When they came to the place called the Skull, they crucified him there, along with the criminals—one on his right, the other on his left. ³⁴Jesus said, "Father, <u>forgive them</u>, for they do not know what they are doing." (Luke 23:32-34 ESV)

HOW DO YOU FORGIVE LIKE JESUS?

1. PRAY FOR THOSE WHO <u>HURT</u> YOU. Bless those who curse you. <u>Pray for those who hurt you</u>. (Luke 6:28 NLT) "You have heard that it was said, 'Love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' ⁴⁴But I tell you, <u>love your enemies</u> and <u>pray for those who persecute you</u>. (Matthew 5:43-44 NIV)

2. FORGIVE AS YOU'VE BEEN FORGIVEN.

MEMORY VERSE

...<u>Forgive one another</u> if any of you has a grievance against someone. <u>Forgive as the Lord</u> <u>forgave you</u>. (Colossians 3:13b NIV)
