SERMON: "EVER WONDER: WHY GOD DIDN'T ANSWER MY PRAYER?"

"And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it." (John 14:13-14 NIV)

THE PURPOSE OF PRAYER IS TO KNOW GOD SO WE CAN DO HIS WILL. PRAYER HELPS US TO LIVE <u>RIGHT</u>.

WHY DIDN'T GOD ANSWER MY PRAYER?

I DON'T KNOW BUT SCRIPTURE IMPLIES LIVING RIGHT HELPS OUR PRAYERS.

The eyes of the LORD are toward the righteous and his ears toward their cry. (Psalm 34:15 ESV)

WHAT IS HINDERING YOUR PRAYERS?

1. MAYBE YOU HAVE A BROKEN RELATIONSHIP.

"Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. ²⁵And when you stand praying, <u>if you hold anything against anyone</u>, forgive them, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins." (Mark 11:24-25 NIV)

"Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother or sister has something against you, ²⁴leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to them; then come and offer your gift." (Matthew 5:23-24 NIV)

Husbands, in the same way be considerate as you live with your wives, and treat them with respect as the weaker partner and as heirs with you of the gracious gift of life, so that nothing will hinder your prayers.

(1 Peter 3:7 NIV)

"If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened" (Psalm 66:18 NIV)

2. MAYBE YOU HAVE THE WRONG MOTIVES.

When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures. (James 4:3 NIV)

3. MAYBE YOU LACK FAITH GOD WILL DO IT.

"It has often thrown him into fire or water to kill him. <u>But if you can do anything</u>, take pity on us and help us." ²³"'<u>If you can'?</u>" said Jesus. "<u>Everything is possible for one who believes</u>." ²⁴Immediately the boy's father exclaimed, "I do believe; <u>help me overcome my</u> unbelief!" (Mark 9:22-24 NIV)

- ... "Your faith has healed you." ... (Matthew 9:22 NIV)
- ... "Your faith has saved you ..." (Luke 7:50 NIV)
- \dots "According to your faith let it be done to you"; 30 and their sight was restored. \dots (Matthew 9:29-30 NIV)

And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him. (Hebrews 11:6 NIV)

• WE DON'T PUT OUR FAITH IN FAITH, WE PUT OUR FAITH IN GOD.

4. MAYBE GOD HAS SOMETHING DIFFERENT.

This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. ¹⁵And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him.

(1 John 5:14-15 NIV)

"Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done." (Luke 22:42 NIV)

WHY KEEP PRAYING?

"Therefore God also requires that you lament and plead such necessities and wants, not because He does not know them, but that you may kindle your heart to stronger and greater desires, and make wide and open your cloak to receive much." Martin Luther, Large Catechism
