RIGHTEOUSNESS

What do you think when you hear it?

When we think "righteous" what we often really mean is <u>self-righteous</u>. Greek "dikaiosune" - Justification, <u>right standing</u>, fulfilling the requirements of justice

1. RIGHTEOUSNESS IS NECESSARY

A. WE WERE CREATED FOR COMMUNITY WITH GOD

Then the man and his wife heard the sound of the Lord God as he was walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and they hid from the Lord God among the trees of the garden. But the Lord God called to the man, Where are you?" (Genesis 3, 8-9 NIV)

B. WE CHOOSE TO LEAVE THAT COMMUNITY

Israelites grumbling against god, Idol worship (Exodus 17, 24)

When the Lord began to speak through Hosea, the Lord said to him, "Go, marry a promiscuous woman and have children with her, for like an adulterous wife this land is guilty of unfaithfulness to the Lord." (Hosea 1:2 NIV)

E.g. Luke 15:11-16 - The prodigal son

C. OUTSIDE OF THAT COMMUNITY/RELATIONSHIP, THERE IS SUFFERING

See Ephesians 2 - "Objects of wrath"

The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of people, who suppress the truth by their wickedness, ¹⁹ since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them. ²⁰For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse. (Romans 1:18-20 NIV)

2. WE TRY TO EARN IT

A. IN THE TIME OF PAUL, IT WAS ALL RELIGIOUS

If someone else thinks they have reasons to put confidence in the flesh, I have more: ⁵circumcised on the eighth day, of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; in regard to the law, a Pharisee; ⁶as for zeal, persecuting the church; as for righteousness based on the law, faultless. (Philippians 3:4b-6 NIV)

B. TODAY, WE HAVE RELIGIOUS AND SECULAR THINGS WE DO TO TRY TO EARN IT

3. WE CAN'T EARN IT

A. ALL THIS DOING IS ULTIMATELY EVIL-DOING

Watch out for those dogs, those evildoers... (Philippians 3:2a, NIV)

B. IF WE ARE REALLY "OKAY" OR "GOOD PEOPLE" BECAUSE OF ALL THESE THINGS WE DO, WHY DO WE HAVE TO KEEP TELLING OURSELVES THAT WE'RE OKAY, THAT WE'RE GOOD PEOPLE?

MEMORY VERSE

But whatever were gains to me I now consider loss for the sake of Christ. (Philippians 3:7)

What is more, I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them garbage, that I may gain Christ. (Philippians 3:8)

4. RIGHT STANDING CAN ONLY COME AS A FREE GIFT

I consider them garbage, that I may gain Christ ⁹ and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith in[a] Christ—the righteousness that comes from God on the basis of faith. (Philippians 3:8-9)

For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile. ¹⁷For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed—a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: "The righteous will live by faith." (Romans 1:16-17)

Christ has already <u>made us righteous</u> so there is <u>nothing more</u> we can do (Hosea 2:14-20)

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— onot by works, so that no one can boast. (Ephesians 2:8-9)

CONFESSION (98 Church Campus only)

A: But now God has shown us a way to be made right with him without keeping the requirements of the law, as was promised in the writings of Moses and the prophets long ago.²²We are made right with God by placing our faith in Jesus Christ. And this is true for everyone who believes, no matter who we are. ²³For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. (Romans 3:21-23 NLT)

ABSOLUTION (98 Church Campus only)

P: Yet God, in his grace, freely makes us right in his sight. He did this through Christ Jesus when he freed us from the penalty for our sins. ²⁵For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin. People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed his life, shedding his blood. This sacrifice shows that God was being fair when he held back and did not punish those who sinned in times past, ²⁶for he was looking ahead and including them in what he would do in this present time. God did this to demonstrate his righteousness, for he himself is fair and just, and he makes sinners right in his sight when they believe in Jesus. (Romans 3:24-26 NLT)
