SERMON: "THE HIDDEN GIFT: HONOR HIS NAME"

I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. You shall have no other gods before me. (Deut. 5:6-7)

MEMORY VERSE

"You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold him guiltless who takes his name in vain." (Deut. 5:11)

FIRST COMMANDMENT IS ABOUT THE HEART AND THE SECOND IS ABOUT LIVING IT. (INTEGRITY)

"A son honors his father, and a servant his master. If then I am a father, where is my honor? And if I am a master, where is my fear? says the LORD of hosts to you, O priests, who despise my name. But you say, 'How have we despised your name?' 7By offering polluted food upon my altar. But you say, 'How have we polluted you?' By saying that the LORD's table may be despised. 8When you offer blind animals in sacrifice, is that not evil? And when you offer those that are lame or sick, is that not evil? Present that to your governor; will he accept you or show you favor? says the LORD of hosts. 9And now entreat the favor of God, that he may be gracious to us. With such a gift from your hand, will he show favor to any of you? says the LORD of hosts. 10Oh that there were one among you who would shut the doors, that you might not kindle fire on my altar in vain! I have no pleasure in you, says the LORD of hosts, and I will not accept an offering from your hand. "For from the rising of the sun to its setting my name will be great among the nations, and in every place incense will be offered to my name, and a pure offering. For my name will be great among the nations, says the LORD of hosts. 12 But you profane it when you say that the Lord's table is polluted, and its fruit, that is, its food may be despised. 13But you say, 'What a weariness this is.' and you snort at it, says the LORD of hosts. You bring what has been taken by violence or is lame or sick, and this you bring as your offering! Shall I accept that from your hand? says the LORD 14Cursed be the cheat who has a male in his flock, and vows it, and yet sacrifices to the Lord what is blemished. For I am a great King, says the LORD of hosts, and my name will be feared among the nations. (Malachi 1:6-14)

BIG IDEA: GOD'S NAME <u>MATTERS</u> BECAUSE IT IS HIS CHARACTER AND WORK. WE ARE TO PROTECT IT FROM <u>FALSEHOOD</u> AND FOOLISHNESS. HIS NAME IS TO BE <u>HONORED</u> WITH OUR LIFE SO WE ARE A <u>BLESSING</u> TO OTHERS.

1. GOD'S NATURE AND ATTRIBUTES, THE <u>TOTALITY</u> OF HIS BEING, AND ESPECIALLY HIS GLORY ARE REFLECTED IN HIS NAME.

O LORD, our Lord, how <u>majestic is your name</u> in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens. (Psalm 1:8)

He sent <u>redemption</u> to his people; he has commanded his covenant forever <u>Holy</u> and <u>awesome</u> is his name! (Psalm 111:9)

Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need. (Hebrews 4:16)

2. GOD WARNS US NOT TO USE HIS NAME FLIPPANTLY BY...

"'You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will <u>not hold him</u> <u>quiltless</u> who takes his name in <u>vain</u>." (Deut.5:11)

A. SWEARING

You shall not swear by my name falsely, and so profane the name of your God: I am the LORD.

(Lev. 19:12)

B. CURSING

but no human being can tame the tongue. It is a restless evil, full of deadly poison. With it we bless our Lord and Father, and with it we curse people who are made in the likeness of God. From the same mouth come blessing and cursing. (James 3:8-10a)

C. OATH

But above all, my brothers, do not swear, either by heaven or by earth or by any other oath, but let your "yes" be yes and your "no" be no, so that you <u>may not fall under condemnation</u> (James 5:12)

My brothers, these things ought not to be so. (James 3:10b)

3. WE SHOULD PROTECT HIS NAME FROM FALSEHOOD. (IMITATION)

A. SUPERNATURAL (Fortune Tellers

There shall not be found among you anyone who burns his son or his daughter as an offering, anyone who practices divination or tells fortunes or interprets omens, or a sorcerer "or a charmer or a medium or a necromancer or one who inquires of the dead, 12 for whoever does these things is an abomination to the LORD. (Deuteronomy 18:10-12a)

B. FALSE TEACHING

"Everything that I command you, you shall be careful to do. You shall not add to it or take from it." (Deuteronomy 12:32)

C. PERVERSE PROPHECY

"Behold, I am against the prophets, declares the LORD, who use their tongues and declare, 'declares the LORD.'" (Jeremiah. 23:31)

Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, for many false prophets have gone out into the world. (1 John 4:1)

4. HOW DOES THIS POINT TO JESUS?

I AM (John 8) GOD'S SON (Gal. 4) SANCTIFIER (Heb. 10) RIGHTEOUSNESS (2 Cor. 5)

SAVIOR (1 John) SHEPHERD (John 10) DELIVERER/PEACE (Col. 1)

5. WE HONOR HIS NAME WITH

- A. OBEDIENCE If anyone loves Me, he will obey my teaching. (John 14:23)
- B. KEEPING IT HALLOWED loving admiration and complete devotion, worth/value
- C. <u>WORSHIP</u> Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰so that at the <u>name of Jesus every knee should bow</u>, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, (Philippians 2:9-10)
- **D.** <u>CONFESS</u> and every tongue <u>confess</u> that <u>Jesus Christ is Lord</u>, to the <u>glory</u> of God the Father. (Philippians 2:11)
- E. <u>HEALING</u> But Peter said, "I have no silver and gold, but what I do have I give to you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk!" (Acts 3:6)
- F. <u>FORGIVENESS</u> <u>bearing</u> with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, <u>forgiving</u> each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so <u>you also must forgive</u>. (Colossians 3:13)

G. DOING EVERYTHING IN HIS NAME

And whatever you do, in word or deed, <u>do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus</u>, giving thanks to God the Father through him. (Colossians 3:17)

LORD'S PRAYER

Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.
