ONE OF THE REASONS THAT SO MANY PEOPLE DOUBT CHRISTIANITY ISN'T BECAUSE OF THE WAY JESUS _____, AND NOT BECAUSE OF THE WAY THAT HE _____. IT'S BECAUSE OF WHAT HE _____.

MEMORY VERSE

Jesus answered, “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.” (John 14:6 NIV)

BUDDHISM: No god, no afterlife, countless rebirths

HINDUISM: Impersonal god through idols, statues, deities

BUDDHISM AND HINDUISM: No forgiveness nor supernatural help, only karma.

MUSLIM: Allah is a personal god, your standing with god depends on your works

NEW AGE: Seeking higher consciousness, being one with the cosmos

CHRISTIANITY: A personal God who loves His people unconditionally, who became one of them in the person of Jesus and sacrificed his life for the forgiveness of sins.

1. CONSIDER THE _____ OF JESUS.

When the teachers of the law who were Pharisees saw [Jesus] eating with the sinners and tax collectors, they asked his disciples: “Why does he eat with tax collectors and sinners?”¹⁷ On hearing this, Jesus said to them, “It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners.”

(Mark 2:16-17 NIV)

2. CONSIDER THE _____ OF JESUS.

“You killed the author of life, but God raised him from the dead. We are witnesses of this.” (Acts 3:15 NIV)

3. CONSIDER THE _____ OF JESUS.

This is how you can recognize the Spirit of God: Every spirit that acknowledges that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God ... (1 John 4:2 NIV)

“He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death’ or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.” (Revelation 21:4 NIV)

We are made right with God by placing our faith in Jesus Christ. And this is true for everyone who believes, no matter who we are. (Romans 3:22 NLT)

GOING DEEPER IN THE HOME

1. Read John 14:6. Truth isn't an idea; it's the person of Jesus. How does this influence how you share truth with others?
2. Share a truth about Jesus that helps you remember how He is different from other world religions. How does this truth impact your view of God?
3. Think about the way Jesus lived and loved. What stands out to you about His life, and how could that influence the way you live yours?
