1. BOLDNESS ALMOST ALWAYS TRIGGERS SPIRITUAL

They <u>arrested</u> the apostles and <u>put them in the public jail</u>. (Acts 5:18 NLT)

2.	BOLDNESS OFTEN PROCEEDS GOD'S
	But an angel of the Lord came at night, opened the gates of the jail,
	and brought them out. (Acts 5:19 NLT)

3.	BOLDNESS ALWAYS REQUIRES
	"Go to the Temple and give the people this message of life!" 21 So at
	daybreak the apostles entered the Temple, as they were told, and

immediately began teaching. (Acts 5:20-21 NLT)
