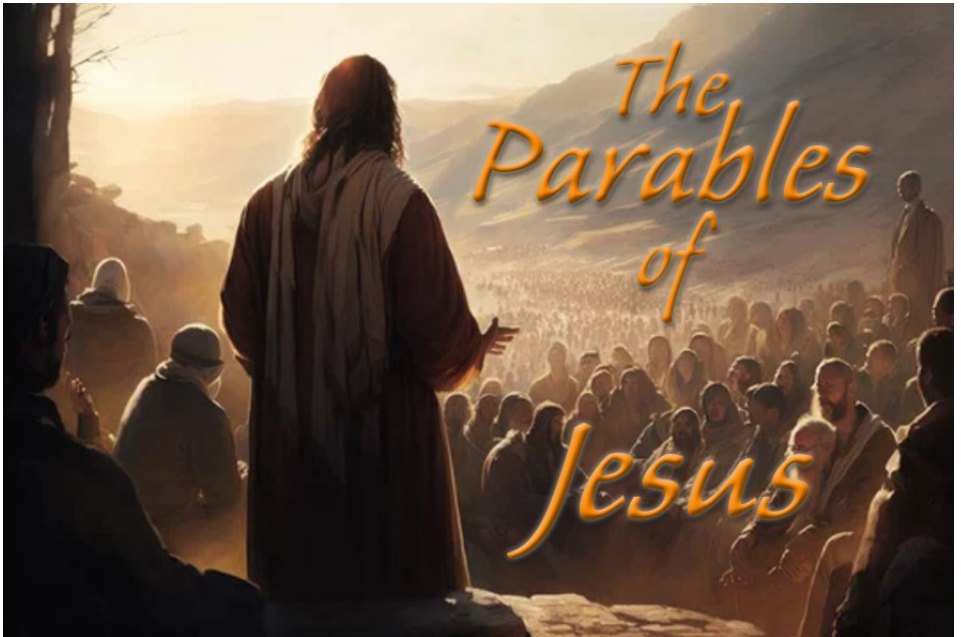

Do you think that I have come to give peace on earth? No, I tell you, but rather division. (Luke 12:5)

MEMORY VERSE
