

Submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ.²²Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. 23 For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior. ²⁴Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit in everything to their husbands. (Ephesians 5:21-24)

1. BECAUSE COMMUNITY MATTERS...

A. JESUS ______ LIVED IN COMMUNITY. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. (Hebrews 4:15)

B. JESUS ______ INTO COMMUNITY. And he appointed twelve (whom he also named apostles) so that <u>they</u> might be with him and he might send them out to preach (Mark 3:14)

C. JESUS WAS FULL OF _____

And Jesus increased in wisdom and in stature and in favor with God and man. (Luke 2:52)

Although he was a son, he learned obedience through what he suffered. (Hebrews 5:8)

2. WE HAVE BEEN ______ INTO HIS COMMUNITY. "For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." (Mark 10:45)

MEMORY VERSE

But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. (1 Peter 2:9)

3. BECAUSE OF GOD'S GRACE WE...

- A. HAVE _____ IN CHRIST NOT THE WORLD. I do not ask that you take them out of the world, but that you keep them from the evil one. (John 17:15)
- **B.** LIVE IN A FAITH COMMUNITY. And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. (Acts 2:42)

C. _____ IN OUR FAITH AND EACH OTHER.

And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. ⁴⁶And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, (Acts 2:45-46a)

D. GROW IN ______ WHICH GIVES SECURITY.

Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, ⁴and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, ⁵and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us. (Romans 5:3-5)

But rejoice insofar as you share Christ's sufferings, that you may also rejoice and be glad when his glory is revealed. (1 Peter 4:13)
