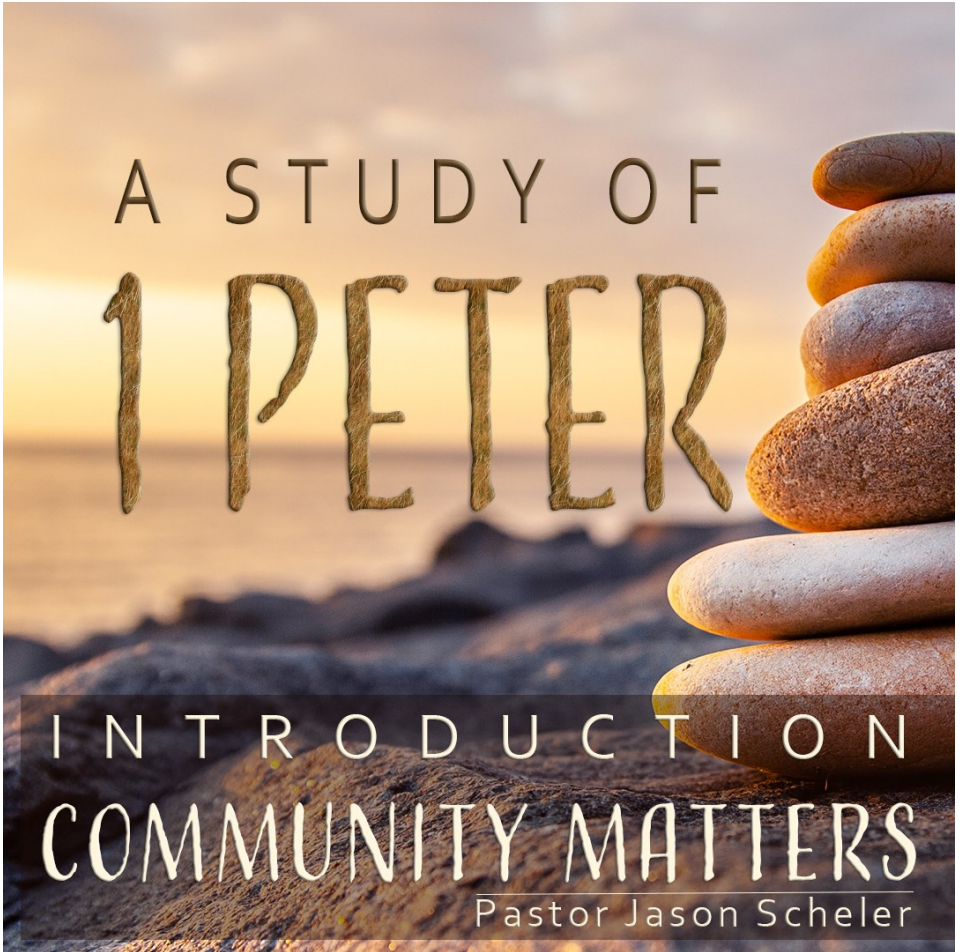

Submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ.²²Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. ²³For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior. ²⁴Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit in everything to their husbands. (Ephesians 5:21-24)

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son," (John 3:16a)

1. BECAUSE COMMUNITY MATTERS...

A. JESUS _____ LIVED IN COMMUNITY.

For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. (Hebrews 4:15)

B. JESUS _____ INTO COMMUNITY.

And he appointed twelve (whom he also named apostles) so that they might be with him and he might send them out to preach (Mark 3:14)

C. JESUS WAS FULL OF _____.

And Jesus increased in wisdom and in stature and in favor with God and man. (Luke 2:52)

Although he was a son, he learned obedience through what he suffered. (Hebrews 5:8)

2. WE HAVE BEEN _____ INTO HIS COMMUNITY.

"For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." (Mark 10:45)

MEMORY VERSE

But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. (1 Peter 2:9)

3. BECAUSE OF GOD'S GRACE WE...

A. HAVE _____ IN CHRIST NOT THE WORLD.

I do not ask that you take them out of the world, but that you keep them from the evil one. (John 17:15)

B. _____ LIVE IN A FAITH COMMUNITY.

And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. (Acts 2:42)

C. _____ IN OUR FAITH AND EACH OTHER.

And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. ⁴And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, (Acts 2:45-46a)

D. GROW IN _____ WHICH GIVES SECURITY.

Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, ⁴and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, ⁵and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us. (Romans 5:3-5)

But rejoice insofar as you share Christ's sufferings, that you may also rejoice and be glad when his glory is revealed. (1 Peter 4:13)
