*As you come to him, a living stone (1 Peter 2:4)*

*So put away all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander. (1 Peter 2:1)*

I will send my beloved son; perhaps they will respect him....’ <sup>15</sup>And they threw him out of the vineyard and killed him. What then will the owner of the vineyard do to them?
