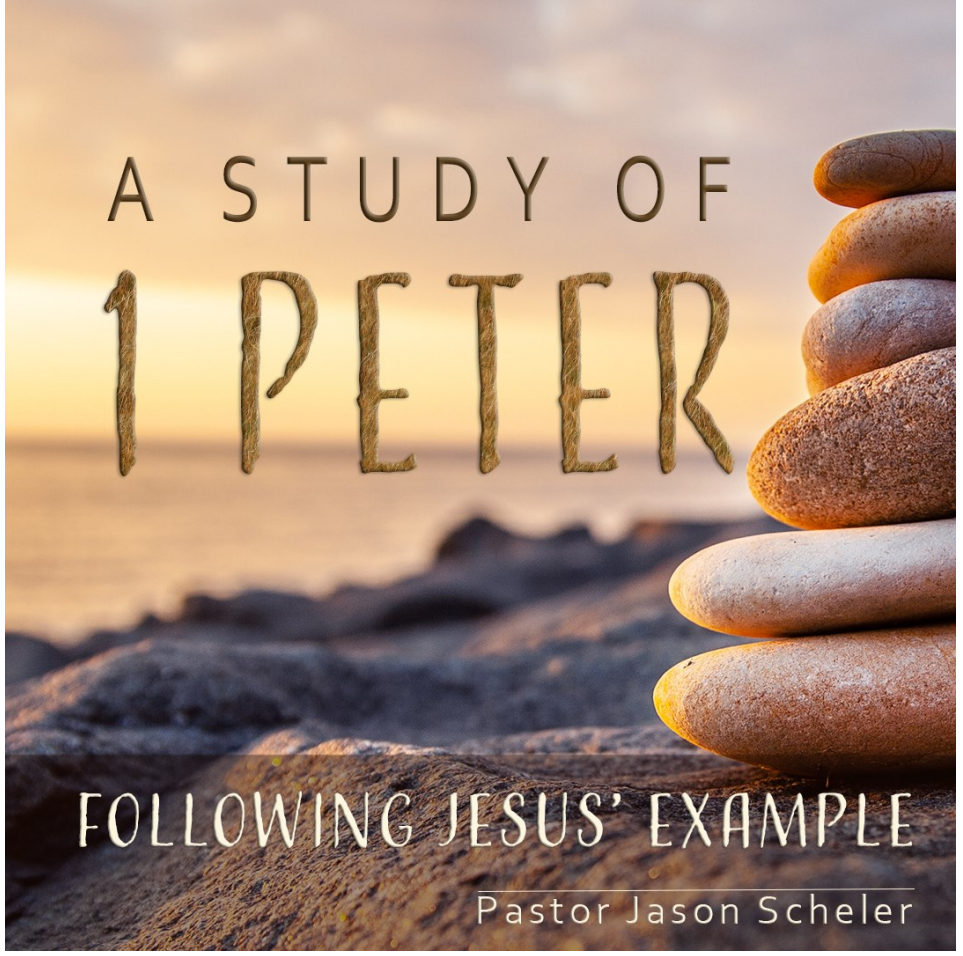

YOU ARE GOD’S _____

Dear friends, I urge you, as foreigners and exiles, (1 Peter 2:11a NIV)

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God’s special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. ¹⁰Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy. (1 Peter 2:9-10 NIV)

1. OUR LIFE IS DEFINED AND SUSTAINED BY GOD’S _____, NOT OUR WILL.

to abstain from sinful desires, which wage war against your soul.

(1 Peter 2:11b NIV)

2. CHRISTIANS GO _____ AND _____ FOR THEIR NEIGHBOR.

Live such good lives among the pagans that, though they accuse you of doing wrong, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day he visits us. (1 Peter 2:11-12 NIV)

“You have heard that it was said, ‘Eye for eye, and tooth for tooth.’ ³⁹But I tell you, do not resist an evil person. If anyone slaps you on the right cheek, turn to them the other cheek also. ⁴⁰And if anyone wants to sue you and take your shirt, hand over your coat as well. ⁴¹If anyone forces you to go one mile, go with them two miles. ⁴²Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you. (Matthew 5:38-42 NIV)

3. _____ AND RESPECT WORLDLY CORRUPT HUMAN AUTHORITY

Submit yourselves for the Lord’s sake to every human authority: whether to the emperor, as the supreme authority, ¹⁴or to governors, who are sent by him to punish those who do wrong and to commend those who do right.....Show proper respect to everyone, love the family of believers, fear God, honor the emperor. (1 Peter 2:13-14,17 NIV)

4. WHY SHOULD WE SUBMIT?

A. LORD'S _____ SAKE

For it is God's will that by doing good you should silence the ignorant talk of foolish people. (1 Peter 2:15 NIV)

B. LIVE _____ AS GOD'S SLAVES UNDER HIS POWER.

Live as free people, but do not use your freedom as a cover-up for evil; live as God's slaves. (1 Peter 2:16 NIV)
(Ref. Philippians 2:6-11 NIV)

C. _____ AND GRACE REST ON PERSECUTED

For it is commendable if someone bears up under the pain of unjust suffering because they are conscious of God. ²⁰But how is it to your credit if you receive a beating for doing wrong and endure it? But if you suffer for doing good and you endure it, this is commendable before God. (1 Peter 2:19-20 NIV)

D. _____ TO FOLLOW JESUS' EXAMPLE

*To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example, that you should follow in his steps. ²²"He committed no sin, and no deceit was found in his mouth."
²³When they hurled their insults at him, he did not retaliate; when he suffered, he made no threats.
(1 Peter 2:21-23a NIV)*

iii. _____ YOURSELF AND THE INJUSTICE TO YOUR HEAVENLY FATHER WHO JUDGES AND CARES FOR YOU.

*Instead, he entrusted himself to him who judges justly. ²⁴"He himself bore our sins" in his body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; "by his wounds you have been healed."
²⁵For "you were like sheep going astray," but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.
