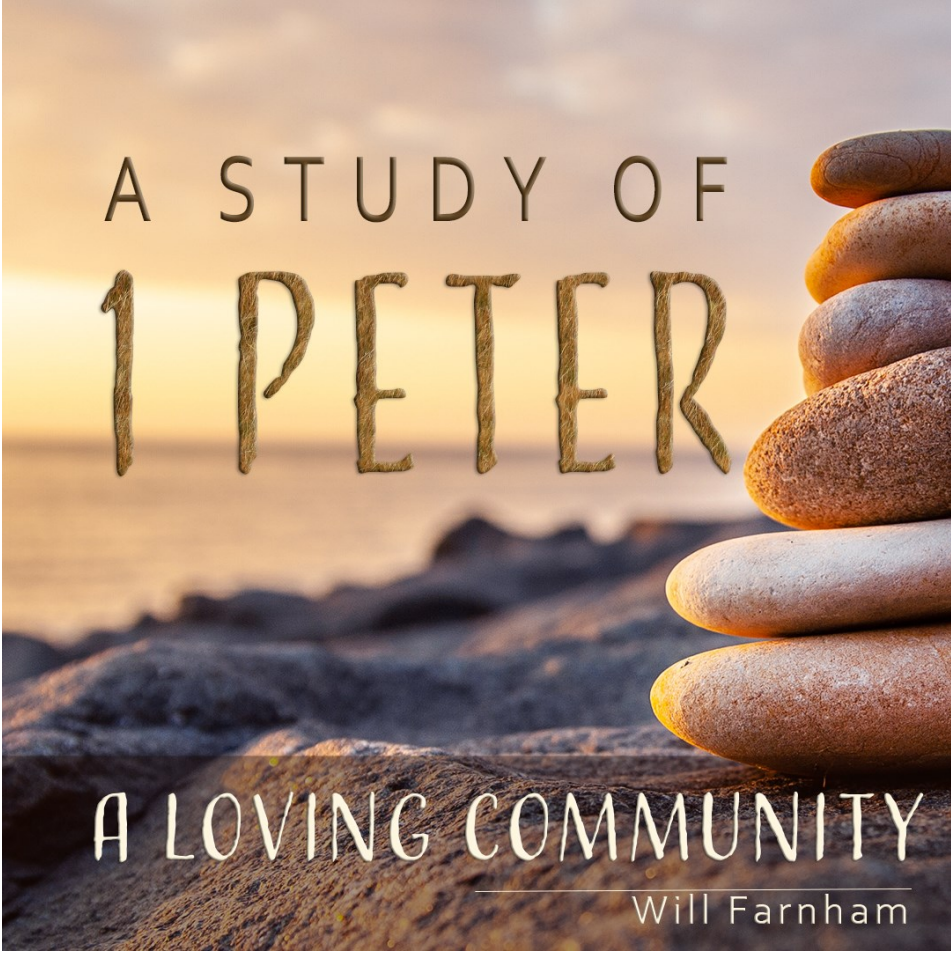

MEMORY VERSE

For it is better to suffer for doing good, if that should be God's will, than for doing evil. (1 Peter 3:17 ESV)

I. IF PEOPLE DON’T LIKE YOU, LET IT BE FOR THE _____ REASONS.

Now who is there to harm you if you are zealous for what is good? ¹⁴But even if you should suffer for righteousness' sake, you will be blessed. (1 Peter 3:13-14)

II. A PRICKED _____ PROVIDES AN OPPORTUNITY FOR THE SPIRIT TO WORK.

... those who revile your good behavior in Christ may be put to shame. (1 Peter 3:16b)

4. WE FIND THE STRENGTH TO LIVE THIS WAY THROUGH OUR _____ IN CHRIST.

For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit, ¹⁹in which he went and proclaimed to the spirits in prison, ²⁰because they formerly did not obey, when God's patience waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through water. ²¹Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, ²²who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, authorities, and powers having been subjected to him. (1 Peter 3: 18-22)

And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" that is, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" ... ⁵¹And behold, the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. And the earth shook, and the rocks were split. ⁵²The tombs also were opened. And many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised... (Matthew 27:46, 51-52)

- D. HE WAS STRIPPED _____ TO GIVE US IMPENETRABLE ARMOR AGAINST SUFFERING.

Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus into the governor's headquarters, and they gathered the whole battalion before him. ²⁸And they stripped him... (Matthew 27:27-28a)

Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, ¹⁵and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. ¹⁶In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one; ¹⁷and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, ¹⁸ praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. (Ephesians 6:14-18a)
