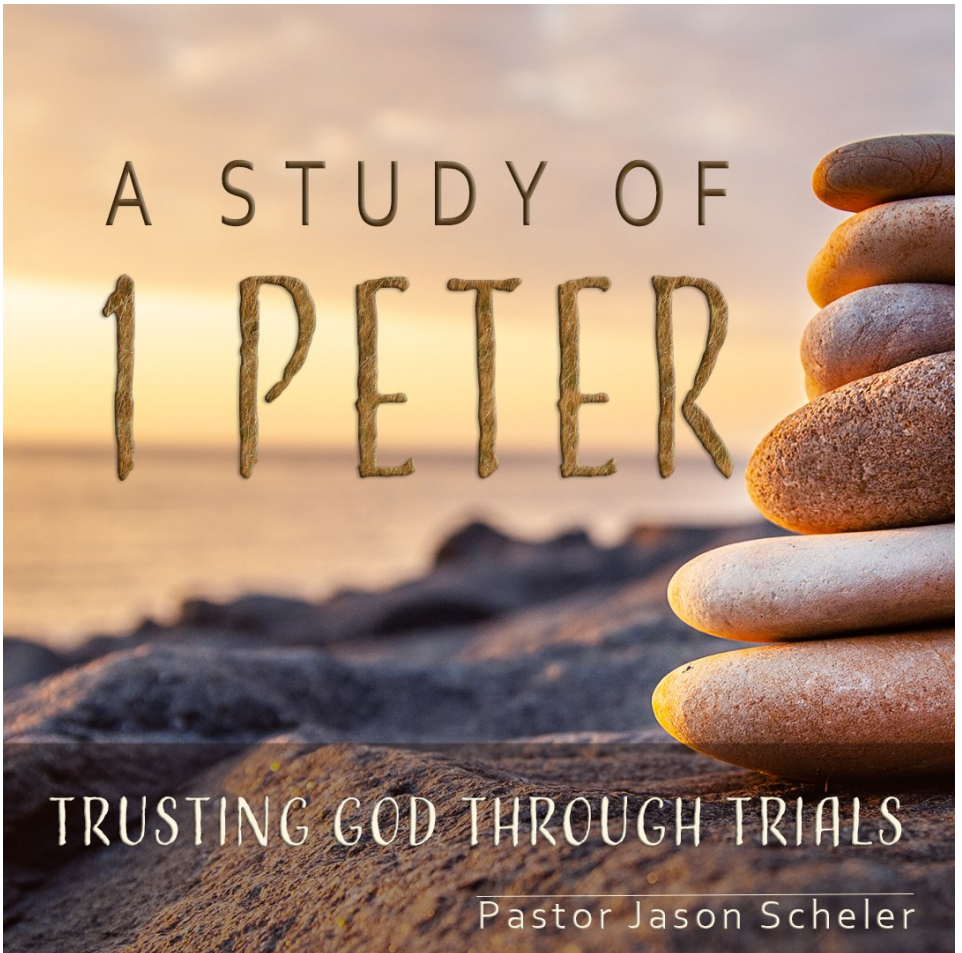

“A STUDY OF 1 PETER: TRUSTING GOD THROUGH TRIALS”

Pastor Jason Scheler

1. EXPERIENCING TRIALS IS A _____ PART OF THE CHRISTIAN FAITH.

Dear friends, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal that has come on you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you.
(1 Peter 4:12 NIV)

Moses said to the people, “Do not be afraid. God has come to test you, so that the fear of God will be with you” (Exodus 20:20a NIV)

because the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and he chastens everyone he accepts as his son. (Hebrews 12:6 NIV)

Remember how the Lord your God led you all the way in the wilderness these forty years, to humble and test you in order to know what was in your heart, whether or not you would keep his commands.
(Deuteronomy 8:2 NIV)

2. OUR RESPONSE IS TO _____.

But rejoice inasmuch as you participate in the sufferings of Christ, so that you may be overjoyed when his glory is revealed. (1 Peter 4:13 NIV)

But he knows the way that I take; when he has tested me, I will come forth as gold. (Job 23:10 NIV)

Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.
(James 1:2-4 NIV)

- **GOING THROUGH TRIALS IS OUR _____ THAT JESUS IS REAL AND MATTERS.**

In all this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials. These have come so that the proven genuineness of your faith—of greater worth than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire—may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed. (1 Peter 1:6-7 NIV)

- 3. **GOD DOESN'T NEED _____ NAME FOR HIS NAME.**

If you are insulted because of the name of Christ, you are blessed, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you. ¹⁵If you suffer, it should not be as a murderer or thief or any other kind of criminal, or even as a meddler. ¹⁶However, if you suffer as a Christian, do not be ashamed, but praise God that you bear that name. (1 Peter 4:14-16 NIV)

Now I know that you fear God, because you have not withheld from me your son, your only son. (Genesis 22:12b NIV)

- 4. **DON'T RUN AWAY BUT _____ IN AND UNDER HIM AND DO _____.**

For it is time for judgment to begin with God's household; and if it begins with us, what will the outcome be for those who do not obey the gospel of God? ¹⁸And, "If it is hard for the righteous to be saved, what will become of the ungodly and the sinner?" ¹⁹So then, those who suffer according to God's will should commit themselves to their faithful Creator and continue to do good. (1 Peter 4:17-19 NIV)
