“PRAY LIKE JESUS: TEMPTATION”

AND LEAD US NOT INTO TEMPTATION

What does this mean? God tempts no one. We pray in this petition that God would guard and keep us so that the devil, the world, and our sinful nature may not deceive us or mislead us into false belief, despair, and other great shame and vice. Although we are attacked by these things, we pray that we may finally overcome them and win the victory. – Luther

One of Satan’s tactics: “I promise you something good if you will do something bad.”

THE FIRST TEMPTATION

And Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the wilderness ²for forty days, being tempted by the devil. And he ate nothing during those days. And when they were ended, he was hungry. ³The devil said to him, “If you are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread.” ⁴And Jesus answered him, “It is written, ‘Man shall not live by bread alone.’” (Luke 4:1-4)

1. WHEN WE PRAY LIKE JESUS, WE TAKE UP A _____.

“...and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God,” (Ephesians 6:17)

Therefore, take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. (Ephesians 6:13)

No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it. (1 Corinthians 10:13)

THE SECOND TEMPTATION

And the devil took him up and showed him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time, ⁶and said to him, To you I will give all this authority and their glory, for it has been delivered to me, and I give it to whom I will. ⁷If you, then, will worship me, it will all be yours.” ⁸And Jesus answered him, “It is written, “You shall worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve.”” (Luke 4:5-8)

2. WHEN WE PRAY LIKE JESUS, WE TAKE HIM AT HIS _____.

Jesus said to him, “Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.” (John 20:29)

THE THIRD TEMPTATION

And he took him to Jerusalem and set him on the pinnacle of the temple and said to him, “If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down from here, ¹⁰for it is written, “He will command his angels concerning you, to guard

you,'¹¹ and “On their hands they will bear you up, lest you strike your foot against a stone.”¹² And Jesus answered him, “It is said, ‘You shall not put the Lord your God to the test.’” (Luke 4:9-12)

3. WHEN WE PRAY LIKE JESUS, WE REMEMBER OUR _____.

This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him.
(Matthew 17:5)

We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. (Romans 6:4)

Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. (James 4:7)

Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men.¹⁹ For as by the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man's obedience the many will be made righteous. (Romans 5:18-19)

THE EPILOGUE

And when the devil had ended every temptation, he departed from him until an opportune time. (Luke 4:13)

4. WHEN WE PRAY LIKE JESUS, WE KEEP _____.

Praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints. (Ephesians 6:18)

“Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.” (1 Peter 5:8)

Watch and pray that you may not enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak. (Matthew 26:41)

For all that is in the world—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride of life—is not from the Father but is from the world. (1 John 2:16)
